

Sister M. Dorothea Micek – 70 Years

Sister M. Dorothea entered our Congregation on July 15, 1939 from Immaculate Conception Parish in Omaha, NE. She helped at St. Joseph Home in Chicago, IL from 1943 until 1944 and at Guardian Angel Day Nursery in Chicago, IL from 1944 to 1946. She taught at St. Stanislaus Bishop & Martyr School in Chicago, IL from 1946 to 1947. In 1947 she began her training as a nurse at St. Joseph School of Nursing in Joliet, IL and continued at Sacred Heart Hospital, Yankton, SD for Anesthesiology training from 1950 to 1951. Sister then served as Nurse Anesthetist and in other nursing duties in South Dakota, Nebraska, and Illinois. She was the head Nurse at Mother of Grace Hospital in Gregory, SD from 1951 until 1954 and a Charge Nurse from 1987 to 1995 at Palos Community Hospital in Palos Heights, IL. Sister received her Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree from Creighton University in Omaha, NE in 1978. From 1982 until 1983 she attended Sangamon State University, Springfield, IL and received a Master's Degree in Gerontology. Sister did her internship for Gerontology at Our Lady of Angels Retirement Home, Joliet, IL in 1983. From 1983 until 1987 she was the administrator and Superior of Mother Theresa Home, Lemont, IL. In August, 1995, Sister retired from nursing and is currently a driver and performs other services for the retired Sisters at the Motherhouse. From 1996 until 1999 she served as the local superior for one of the Communities at the Motherhouse. Sister is currently the assistant local minister.
