

Sister Frances Szczur – 70 Years

Sister Frances Szczur entered our Congregation on August 22, 1939 from Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish, Bayonne, NJ. Sister performed domestic duties at the Motherhouse and Boys Town from 1942 until 1946. After training she served as a nurse in various hospitals in South Dakota from 1948 until 1973. She studied further at Creighton University in Omaha, NE and Marquette University in Milwaukee, WI working towards her Master's Degree in Nursing. Sister was in charge of the Motherhouse Infirmary from 1966 until 1967 and 1983 until 1985. During her service at St. Anthony Medical Center she was Director of Nursing Education, Chairman of the Safety and Handicap Committee, Nursing Education Instructor Specialist, and volunteered at the Patient Admitting Desk. She also served as the local superior of the convent. Sister currently resides at St. Anthony Convent. She received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from Creighton University, Omaha, NE in 1956.
