Sister Dulcissima has spent her ministry doing domestic work and caring for the aged. Sister performed domestic work at St. Florian from 1937 to 1938 and 1944 to 1945, at St. Stanislaus Bishop & Martyr from 1950 to 1952, at the Community's Motherhouse in 1959, and at various Communities in Indiana and Ohio. She also worked in the kitchen at the Motherhouse from 1938 to 1942, at St. Elizabeth Day Care from 1943 to 1944, at Guardian Angel Day Care from 1949 to 1950, at St. Joseph Home from 1961 to 1962 and at various Communities in South Dakota and Indiana. Sister cared for the aged at St. Joseph Home of Chicago from 1970 until 1974. She was a Supervisor at St. Joseph Home of Chicago from 1975 to 1978. She ministered as a nurse's aide and seamstress at Mother Theresa Home from 1978 until 1987. Sister Dulcissima moved to the Motherhouse in Lemont, Illinois in 1987 where she assisted in the archives, infirmary, sewing outfits for the Infant Jesus for the Gift Shop and performed other clerical duties.

Sister Dulcissima retired in 2007.
